

**Congregational Churches in Dukes County, Massachusetts  
(In Alphabetical Order by Town)**

- 1. Congregational Church of Chilmark**
  - a. Founded on Indian Common Land in 1690.**
  
- 2. Nashuakemmuck Indian Congregational Church of Chilmark**
  - a. Founded 1674 and situated on Indian Common Land until 1694.**
  
- 3. Seconchgut Indian Congregational Church of Chilmark**
  - a. Founded 1698.**
  
- 4. Chappaquiddick Indian Congregational Church of Edgartown.**
  - a. Founded as Great Harbor gathering in 1671 (with earliest meetings in 1659).**
  
- 5. Federated Church of Martha's Vineyard (or Martin's Vineyard, or Edgartown)**
  - a. Established in 1641.**
  
- 6. Indian Congregational Church of Gay Head**
  - a. Founded on Indian Common Land in 1674.**
  
- 7. Sanchacantacket Indian Congregational Church of Oak Bluffs**
  - a. Founded in 1642.**
  
- 8. Holmes Hole Congregational Church of Tisbury**
  - a. Founded in 1673.**
  
- 9. Christiantown Indian Congregational Church of West Tisbury**
  - a. Founded in 1680.**
  
- 10. First Congregational Church of West Tisbury (UCC)**
  - a. Gathered in 1653, established 1673 and mixed congregational with Indian until 1704.**
